2017: Vernal - 21st March; Autumnal 23rd Sept  
2018: Vernal - 21st March; Autumnal 23rd Sept  
2019: Vernal - 21st March; Autumnal 23rd Sept

On the biblical solar calendar the falling of the High Days and Sabbaths is precisely the same pattern and count every year with no "leap year" intercalations necessary

**Biblical High Days & Weekly Sabbaths And Apostolic Testimony of Yahushua's Sign Of Jonah**

**Note: Gregorian calendar dates (and days) change each successive year.**

2015 Comparable Rabbinical Lunar Calendar dates: **Note:** This year (2015) the calendar dates approximate the solar calendar on Passover, because the new moon coincides with the occurrence of the observable equinox (these dates progressively fall short against the Solar calendar each year, causing the Rabbinic Passover to be brought into the season of winter - and thus clearly demonstrating its error - to the point of becoming approximately 3 weeks too early by 2018, **when the Rabbinic will have to be adjusted by the adding a full additional 13th (leap year) lunar month to bring the Rabbinic calendar back into line with the actual agricultural seasons on the earth)**
