### NAZOREAN / NAZARENE YISRAELITE SHABBAT SERVICE

#### WE HEAR THE MEDITATION

ISAIAH 58:13–14 (or similar) Our Father YHWH tells us, “If you hold back from pursuing your own interests on my set-apart Day; if you call Shabbat a delight, my *Yom Tov* worth honoring; Then honor me by refraining from your usual doings or pursuing your own interests or even speaking about them. If you hear me, you will find delight in me. I will make you ride on the heights of the land and confirm you in my heritage through your ancestor Ya’aqov, for the mouth of YHWH has spoken.”

#### WE BRACHI YHWH AND HEAR THE QOL SHOFAR

**BARUCH** are you, YHWH our Elohim, **SOVEREIGN** of the Universe, who has sanctified us by your mitzvot and calls us to hear the qol shofar.

*Bah-ruch ah-ta Yah-weh, Eh-lo-hay-nu meh-lech ha-o-lam,  
A-sheer kid-sa-nu beh-mitz-voh-taiv vitz-e-vanu lesh-mo-ah  
kol sho-far.*

*(The Shofar Master sounds the Tekiah – one long note.)*

#### WE BRACHI MESSIAH

**BARUCH** are you, YHWH our Elohim, **SOVEREIGN** of the Universe, who has given us the way of salvation in **MessiYah Yahshua**. Amein.

*Bah-ruch ah-ta Yah-weh, Eh-lo-hay-nu meh-lech ha-o-lam,  
Ah-sheer na-tahn la-nu et deh-rech ha-yeh-shu-ah beh-ma-  
she-ach Yah-shu-a. Ah-main.*

**So with joy you will draw forth [living] water from the springs of salvation!**

*Ush-av-tem [cha-yim] ma-yim beh-sa-sone mi-ma-ay-nai ha-yeh-shu-ah*

## **WE BRACHA ONE ANOTHER**

*On that day Jacob baruch his grandchildren, he said, “In time to come, the people of Yisrael will use you as a Brachat. They will say, ‘May Elohim make you like Ephraim and Menashe’.” (Genesis 48:20)*

(For men and boys) May Elohim make you like Ephraim and Menashe!

*Ye’simcha Elohim ke-Ephraim ve’chi-Menashe!*

(For women and girls) May Elohim make you like Sarah, Rivka, Raquel and Layah!

*Ye’simech Elohim ke-Sarah, Rivka, Ra-chel ve-Lay’ah!*

**May Elohim BRACHA you and watch over you.**

*Ye’varech’echa Elohim ve’yish’merecha.*

**May Elohim shine his face toward you and show you favor.**

*Ya’ir Elohim panav eilecha viy-chuneka.*

**May Elohim be favorably disposed toward you and grant you SHALOM.**

*Yisa Elohim panav eilecha, ve’yasim lecha shalom.*

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## **WE ENTER THE SET-APART HOME**

**How lovely are your tents, O Ya’aqov, your dwelling places, Yisrael.**

*Ma to-vu oh-ha-le-cha, Ya-ah-kov, mish-ke-no-te-cha Yis-rah-el*

**Through your abundant favor we will enter your home;**

**In awe we will bow down within your Set-apart Sanctuary.**

*Va-a-nee, be-rov chas-de-cha, a-vo vey-te-cha,  
Esh-ta-cha-veh, El hay-chal kad-she-cha be-yir-ah-te-cha.*

**We love the house in which you live and the place where  
your radiance resides,**

*Yah-weh a-hav-tee me-on bey-te-cha um-kom mish-kan ke-vo-  
de-cha.*

**We will fall and bow, bending the knee before YHWH our  
Maker.**

*Va-a-nee esh-ta-cha-veh ve-ech-re-ah ev-re-cha lif-nay YHWH o-  
see*

**May our prayers to you be at the appropriate time.**

*Va-a-nee te-fi-la-tee le-cha Yah-weh et ra-tzon*

**In your abundant righteousness, answer us with the truth of  
your Salvation.**

*El-o-him, be-rav chas-de-cha, a-ne-nee be-eh-met Yish-eh-cha*

## **WE RECITE SHEMA, HAVTAH**

**Hear O Yisrael, YHWH is our Elohim, YHWH is One.**

*Shema Yis-ra-el, YHWH E-lo-hey-nu, YHWH E-chad.*

**BARUCH is the name of his esteemed kingdom forever.**

*Ba-ruch shem ke-vod mal-chu-to le-o-lam va-ed.*

**And you will love YHWH your Elohim,**

*Ve-a-hav-ta et YHWH e-lo-hey-cha,*

**With all your heart, with all your soul, and with all your might,  
be-chol le-vav-cha, uv-chol naf-she-cha, u-ve-chol me-o-de-cha.**

**And you will love your neighbor as yourself.**

*Va-hav-ta le-ray-ah-cha ka-moe-cha.*

**Let these words (that I command you this day) be upon your  
heart.**

*Ve-ha-yu ha-de-va-rim ha-en-leh, a-sheer a-no-chi me-tzav-cha  
ha-yom al le-va-ve-cha.*

**You will teach them diligently to your children,**

*Ve-shi-nan-tam le-va-neh-cha, ve-di-bar-ta bam,*

**And speak of them when you sit in your house,**

Be-shiv-te-cha be-vey-te-cha

**When you walk upon the path, when you retire, and when you arise.**

Uv-lech-te-cha va-de-rech, uv-shoch-be-cha uv-ku-me-cha.

**And you will bind them for a sign upon your hand**

Uk-shar-tam le-ot al ya-deh-cha,

**And let them be frontlets between your eyes.**

ve-ha-yu le-to-ta-fot bein ey-ne-cha.

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**And you will write them on the doors and gates of your house,**

U-che-tav-tam al me-zu-zot bey-te-cha u-vish-ah-re-cha.

**WE BRACHA THE BARUCH (BAR-CHU) (Responsive Reading)**

Bar-chu et YHWH Ha-meh-vo-rahch.

**Bar-uch YHWH ha-meh-vo-rahch leh-oh-lam va-ed.**

BRACHI YHWH, the BARUCH One.

**BRACHI YHWH, the BARUCH One, for all eternity.**

Remember the Shabbat day to keep it set-apart.

**Six days will you labor and do all your work; but the seventh day is the Shabbat of YHWH your Elohim, in it you will not do any work.**

For in six days YHWH made the heaven and the earth, the sea and all that is in them, and rested on the seventh day; that is why YHWH baruch the seventh day and set it apart.

**Speak also unto the children of Yisrael saying: Above all, my Shabbatot you will keep; *for this is a sign***

***between me and you throughout your generations, so that you may know that I am YHWH who sanctifies you.***

The Yisraelites are to observe the Shabbat, celebrating it for the generations to come as an enduring covenant.

**It will be a sign between me and the Yisraelites forever, for in six days YHWH made the heavens and the earth, and on the seventh day he abstained from work and rested.**

And it will come to pass that from one new moon to another and from one Shabbat to another,

**ALL flesh will come to worship before me, says YHWH.**

**WE GIVE THANKS AND PRAISE**

{Here you may sing psalms, read psalms, give witness.}

**WE HEAR THE WORD AND TEACHING**

*Parashot may here be read.*

*Teaching may here be given.*

**WE PRAY TOGETHER**

*Prayers and Benedictions, The Amidah, or other may be here, followed by a psalm.*

*The Todah Rabbah or Communion may be substituted, followed by a psalm.*

**WE SING THE SONG OF Shalom:** *Shalom, My Friends*

*Shalom to you now, shalom, my friends. May YHWH's mercies bless you well, my friends.*

*In all your living and through your loving, YHWH be your shalom, shalom, shalom,*

*YHWH be your shalom.*

**THE MINISTER BRACHAT**

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**YHWH BRACHA you and keep you,**

Yeh-va-reh-cheh-cha YHWH veh-yeesh-meh-reh-cha,

**YHWH make his face shine upon you and GRANT FAVORS to you,**

Ya-air YHWH pa-naiv ay-leyh-cha vee-chu-neh-cha,

**YHWH lift up his countenance upon you and give you**

**SHALOM.**

Yee-sa YHWH pa-nahv ay-leyh-cha veh-ya-same leh-cha Shalom.
