Gen 7:24 And the waters were mighty on the earth, **one hundred and fifty days**.

Gen 8:3 And the waters receded steadily from the earth, and **at the end of the hundred and fifty days** the waters diminished.

Gen 8:4 And in the **seventh month, the seventeenth day of the month**, the ark rested on the mountains of Ararat.

Gen 8:5 And the waters decreased steadily until the tenth month. In the tenth month, on the first day of the month, the tops of the mountains became visible. At

Gen 8:13 And it came to be in the **six hundred and first year**, in the **first month, the first day of the month**, that the waters were dried up from the earth. And Noah removed the covering of the ark and looked, and saw the surface of the ground was dry.

Gen 8:14 And in the **second month, on the twenty-seventh day of the month**, the earth was dry. Gen 8:15 And Elohim spoke to Noah, saying, Gen 8:16 "Go out of the ark,

you and your wife and your sons and your sons' wives with you. Gen 8:17 "Bring out with you every living creature of all flesh that is with you: of birds, of cattle and all creeping creatures that creep on the earth. And let them teem on the earth, and bear and increase on the earth."

Jubilee 5: 31-32 And the waters disappeared from above the earth in the first week in the seventh year [1657 A.M.] thereof, and on the

seventeenth day in the second month the earth **was dry**. And on the **twenty-seventh thereof he opened the ark, and sent forth from it beasts, and cattle, and birds, and every moving thing** Jubilee 6: 1 6:1 And on the **first day of the third month** he went forth from the ark and built an altar on that mountain.

Please pay attention to the verses in **Genesis 8 Chapters 3 to 4:**

Gen 8:3 And the waters receded steadily from the earth, and **at the end of the hundred and fifty days** the waters diminished.

Gen 8:4 And in the **seventh month, the seventeenth day of the month, the ark rested on the mountains of Ararat**.

The Scripture told us here that the seventh-month, day17th has already passed "150 days."

From **Month 2 day 17th** to **Month 7 day 14th** is **150 days**, **Month 2 day 17th** to the **Month 7 day 16th** is **exactly 5 months, total 152 days; 5 months is: 150 days (a month is 30 days X 5) + 2 days** (Season transitional days); seasonal change from summer solstice to autumn equinox = 152 Days.

Therefore, **Month 7 day 17th** is day 153. On the **Month 7, day 17th** in Noah's genesis Flood account, the Ark stopped on Mount Ararat.

The Dead Sea Scroll 4Q252 records that Noah's Ark was over 150 days on **Month 7 day 14** (the third day of the week). After that, on the fourth and fifth days, the water abated, and on the sixth day the ark (**Month 7 day 17**) stopped at Mount Ararat.

4Q252, fr. I (Gen. vi, 3—XV, 17)

I [In the] four hundred and eightieth year of the life of Noah came their end (that of antediluvian mankind). And God said, My spirit shall not abide *in* man for ever and their days *sball* be determined to be one hundred and twenty years (Gen. vi, 3) - until the end of the Flood. And the waters of the *Flood arrived on the earth in the six hundredth year of the life of Noah, in the second month—* on the first day of the week —*on the seventeenth* (of the month). *On that day all the fountains of the great deep burst forth and the windows of the heavens were opened. And rain fell on the earth forty days and forty nights* (vii, 11—12) until the twenty-sixth day of the third month, the fifth day of the week. *And the waters prevailed upon the [ea]rth a hundred and fifty days* (vii, 24)—until the fourteenth day of the seventh month, the third day of the week. *And at the end of a hundred and fifty days, the waters had abated—* two days, the fourth and the fifth day, and on the sixth day - *the ark came to rest on the mountains of Hurarat* (or: Turarat),

waters] dried up from the earth and] Noah removed the covering of the ark and looked, and behold, the face of the ground was dry (viii, 13). This was the *first day of the first month*. [And it happened] II in the *six hundred and first year of the life of Noah, on the seventeenth day of the second month that the earth was dry* (viii, 14) - on the first day of the week. *On that day Noah went forth from the ark* (viii, 18) *at the end of a full year of three hundred and sixty-four days, on the first day of the week, on the seven[teenth] of the second month vacat* on and six *vacat* Noah from the ark at the appointed time of a full year *vacat* *And Noah awoke from his wine and knew what his youngest son had done to him. And he said, Cursed be Canaan; a slave of slaves shall he be to [his] bro[thers]* (ix, 24—5). But he did not curse Ham but only his son, for God had blessed the *sons of Noah. And let him dwell in the tents of Shem* (ix, 27). He gave the land to Abram, his beloved. [Terah] was one hundred and for[t]y-five years old when he *went forth from Ur of the Chaldees and came to Haran* (xi, 31). Now Ab[ram was se]venty years old and for five years Abram dwelt in Haran. And afterwards Abram went forth to the land of Canaan. Six[ty-five years] ... *the heifer and the ram and the go[af]* (xv, 9) ... [the torch of] *fire when it pass[ed over]* (xv, 17) ...

The evidence provided by the ancient dead sea scroll coincides with the "Genesis" calendar

RE: Noah's Flood Account. Month2 day17 to month7 day 14th (the third day of the week) is 150 days, and month7 day 15th and 16th are on the fourth and fifth days of the week. On the sixth day of the week which is month 7 day 17th, the Ark stopped on Mount Ararat.
